Cost: \$2998 plus \$298/348 round trip airfare from an Ohio city to our international departure city plus \$298 for the Passion Play ticket. Regular fees are in addition. Your basic cost includes Round Trip International Airfare, Deluxe Motorcoaches, First Class Hotels, Guided Sightseeing, Entrance Fees, Breakfast & Dinner daily.
